PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

PARENTS SHOULD

- Encourage but do not force children to be active.
- Know when he/she is ready to play.
- Encourage healthy lifestyle habits.
- Attend training and games where possible.
- Promote and teach FAIR PLAY
- Be positive or be quiet, negative comments are counterproductive.
- Teach your child to treat referees, other players, coaches, officials, spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, colour, sex or ability.
- Help children to set realistic targets.
- Help children with decision making.
- Make every effort to be on time for all team events, whether its training or matches. If I am not in attendance of the event, I will make sure to promptly pick up my child or make arrangements for their safe return home. I will also alert my child's coach if I or the person collecting my child is going to be late.
- When using social media, whether personal or club related, parents must take responsibility and not make any comments that may reflect negatively on the reputation of Clones Town FC
- Be aware that information will be shared with FAI via their FAI.net registration system.

PARENTS NEVER

- Insult players or club personnel
- Argue with, or shout abuse at officials and they should actively discourage children and young players likewise.
- Suggest or encourage cheating, aggressive or dirty play.
- Place under pressure or criticism on a player, causing the player unnecessary or unhealthy levels of stress.
- Behave with physical or verbal aggressions towards another person (actually use force or threaten to use force)
- Engage in any harassment type of behaviour.
